I am unable to attend the discussion of this agenda item and would like to offer the following input.

I am in favor of the land acquisition proposal that the Economic Sustainability Committee is proposing to the Board. I would like to see the property used for public washrooms and an attractive, visible, accessible information booth,

Currently neither facility is readily available or visible to the public. Since the economy of the town of Liberty Grove is highly dependant on visitors to our community it is unwise not to have adequate facilities available.

This project would enhance not only the immediate community it serves and the visiting population, it would enhance the value of Liberty Grove as a whole. If part of the Boards mission is to promote and encourage business opportunities and appropriate land use, this project helps satisfy that goal. Any prospective business buyer will assess the health of a community by its physical appearance, the vitality of existing businesses, and available supportive services before they choose to locate. Vacant lots, derelict structures and unsightly conditions discourage positive economic growth.

Improvement to the infrastructure of the town has a positive impact on the whole community and in that regard, as a business owner and home owner , I support the acquisition of this property and any improvements which would result in public restrooms and an adequate information center. I also support the concept of maintaining appropriate green space on the acquired land.
